San Miguel Hills Loop links Golden Gate Park to Twin Peaks and Glen Canyon. The proposed trail loop uses mostly existing trails, with proposed increased public access in a few sections. The benefits that would be provided include:

- Stewardship of neglected areas
- Better access to new and underutilized open space areas
- Outdoor experiences for all ages
- Support for our environment and indigenous animals and plants
- New trails for hikers and runners

The accompanying map lists several locations where trail improvements are in progress or proposed, as described below:

Map Notes

- 1** Connection to Kirkham St, shown in UCSF long range development plan
- 2** Proposed trail on SFPUC owned land that currently has a lot of "No Trespassing" signs and homeless encampments
- 3** Gravel road behind Laguna Honda would be opened to public, while maintaining lake's existing fenced perimeter
- 4** SFUR partnership with Laguna Honda Hospital on rehabilitation of an old trail system, habitat restoration, future watershed improvements.
- 5** Improved access from Mission District, via future trail under Market St Viaduct
- 6** Proposed crosswalk at new Clarendon Trail.
